Staff employed by SteelWatch are remunerated based on market-based remuneration in line with not-for-profit organisations, according to the country where they are operating from. Management Board members can be employed by the foundation but do not receive any additional remuneration for their role as Management Board member. The Supervisory Board determines the remuneration and other terms and conditions of employment of the chairperson of the Management Board and the chairperson of the Management Board decides the remuneration and other terms and conditions of employment of the other employed Management Board members.
